


Year 2 History Knowledge Organiser: Significant People in our Locality

significant		Having great value or importance.
timeline		A chronology of events and their dates, listed from left to right along a line or in a column.
typewriter		A machine that produces type similar to that of print. Keys are pressed with the fingers to activate letters, numbers, or characters.
technology		The inventions and methods of solving problems that are produced through research.
		
telephone		A machine for talking to somebody else over long distances. A telephone has a part for speaking into and a part for listening.
change		To make something different or to change it.
invention		The act or process of creating something new.

Key Knowledge

1. Ada Lovelace and Alan Turing are both from West London. Ada was born in Ealing whilst Alan was born in Maida Vale.
2. Bill Gates founded the Microsoft software that we use on our laptops and computers. There is Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint amongst other computer programmes.
3. Mobile phones were invented in 1973. It was called the Motorola DynaTAC and was only used to make phone calls. You could not use it to play games, take pictures or search the internet.
