This data shows that pupils eligible for the pupil premium grant progress broadly in line with pupils that are not eligible for the grant, due to effective targeted provision. It also shows that a similar number of pupils eligible for the pupil premium grant achieve more than expected progress to those pupils not eligible for the grant, due to effective targeted provision.
